

## What happens if someone gets sick at Windgap?



The health and safety of you and your friends and workers at Windgap is very important to us.



You may have heard of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). It's a bit like a flu that has affected many people around the world.



If one of your friends does not feel well, tell your carer or team leader and they will call the doctor.



Wash your hands regularly and listen to the directions from your carer or team leader.



If your friend is sick with the Coronavirus they will need to stay in hospital until they are well.



We will need to clean the house to make sure no one else gets sick. You and your housemates will need to leave the house until the house is cleaned.



You and your housemates will have to stay in your home for 14 days too, so we can make sure you are not sick and no one else gets sick.



Everyone in the house will need to wear things that doctors may wear to stop others from getting sick, like a face mask and gloves. This helps keep you safe.



Coronavirus is spread through a cough or a sneeze or touching something someone with Coronavirus touched.



To stop the spread of Coronavirus:

- Do not shake hands, hug or kiss
- Try to keep 2 big steps between you and other people.



We don't want to make your family sick, so they won't be able to visit. But don't worry, your carers will make sure you get to talk to your family through video and lots of phone calls.
