Growability Garden Crew

Residential and commercial properties within the community, guided by our professional Growability team leaders.

Barista skills, catering and customer service at our onsite Tukkabox café.

- Learn food preparation, using kitchen equipment and how to make barista coffees!
- Windgap also has Work Training partners at the Pullman Hotel and Taronga Zoo, providing pathways to employment.

Warehouse operations

Picking, packing and process work in Windgap's purpose built, commercial warehouse.

- Work in a team on a range of jobs, from sorting, labeling items, and building boxes.
